The data reveals a troubling trend with an overall net loss in tree cover, which has declined by nearly 6%. In the State of Pará, recent incidents have been reported, including a fire alert that underscores the ongoing threats to Brazil's forests. The cumulative effect of these losses over the years has led to a significant disturbance in the natural landscape, with only a fraction of the lost cover being replenished through gains.
