Argentina is facing a significant environmental challenge as recent data reveals a surge in wildfire incidents and a substantial loss of tree cover. Over the past two decades, the country has experienced a net loss of over 3.50 million hectares of tree cover, marking a 10.45% decrease in its forested areas. This loss is primarily driven by shifting agriculture, which accounts for the highest percentage of tree cover loss, followed by forestry activities.

The latest incident from Neuquén Province underscores the ongoing threat of wildfires to Argentina's landscapes.
